OLD BUSINESS

Weed Spraying: Last year we did not get to spray the weeds. We use to have someone that volunteered to spray. Unfortunately, we no longer have anyone to help us do this. Bids for this job runs at about \$3,000. **We desperately need people to help at work parties or we will have to start having it hired out.** Last time we bought just the spray and it cost us \$800. If we hire out it depletes our funds and then we can't fix or add new things to the range.

Discussion as to how the club can cover the costs and/or get more participation. Do we raise dues, how to contact members about work parties, do we send letters, emails, or have penalties for not participating. Possible exemption clause if people can't afford to pay their dues.

NEW BUSINESS

Summer Schedule:

Opinion Regarding Picnic/Swap: When would the club like to have it? Before July 1 or see about the third week of June (due to the heat). Maybe do demonstrations of different shoots so that more people will get interested in them.

The 50/50 shoot is still happening. Currently have 4 to 5 guys that show up. It is on the 2nd Saturday of every month and starts at 9am. Usually meets March through November. Dale asked Darrel if he would do a presentation for the club. He said yes.

- Pipe pockets – Need three to four people.
- Need a brush beater – will need 6 people.
- Need a small trailer for hauling weeds.
- Door latches need to be replaced, also check the doors on the bathrooms.

Perimeter Fence- Dale would like to have someone check the fence and see if hot signs are still up.
Get rid of tires and junk.

Railroad ties – We need a crew with muscle. We are doing the loading.

There was a request to buy a new tractor. Dale said yes. Try to sell on Craigs list.

Other New Business:

A member asked if we will allow shooting a .22 rifle (long gun) on the pistol range? Answer is NO, due to ricochets.
