### OLD BUSINESS

Discussion about signage for the perimeter. Dale has not heard back from any contractors. The signs will be 4 feet wide x 2 feet high and say "Danger Live Firing Range". The "Live Firing Range" must be on it. To be considered legal. They must be legible by 250 feet by the average eye. They are aluminum with vinyl coating. The long sections should have 4 signs while the shorter sections should have 3. We need 12 of them and they will be attached to the fence. An estimated cost is \$1,400. It was brought up that Bickford Signs makes them. Dale stated that this was the company that made them in the past.

The club agreed to have Dale get the signs. It was then mentioned that there will be an additional cost to add the T-posts with the new hardware. The club has about 350 T-posts, so just need to get the hardware.

Voted for 12 signs, for \$1,400. All were in favor.

Milt asked if the President or the Board can spend this money without approval from the club. Dale said this is a gray area, and the Board has ruling, however he feels that the club should be the ones to decide on expenditures.

**Trap Shoot:** Do we have any support for the trap shoots? Once it cools off we will get it going again. The Trap shoot is held on the third Saturday of each month.

**The 50/50 Shoot is back on.** The second Saturday of the month, August 13<sup>th</sup> at 9am.

**Separate Topic:** Phil said that someone left a shooting bag at the range.

**New Members:** Two new members were moved, seconded, and accepted to the Club. New Members need to go through orientation with Phil.
