We can't rent the Range, but the City Council can pay for new targets. Should we do a contract? More questions need to be answered.

Discussion about us being a non-profit club and taxes.

Targets: In the past, Clint has donated his time and money and made our targets. They now need to be replaced. We should reimburse him the cost of making them.

Jim Sly was at the Range this month and did tumble weed duty for us. Thank you!

OLD BUSINESS:
